Kristin Hannah is the award-winning and bestselling author of more than 20 novels including the international blockbuster, *The Nightingale*, which was named Goodreads Best Historical fiction novel for 2015 and won the coveted

People's Choice award for best fiction in the same year. Additionally, it was a selection of the Reese Witherspoon Book Club in 2023. In 2018, *The Great Alone* became an instant New York Times #1 bestseller and was named the Best Historical Novel of the Year by Goodreads.



The Four Winds was published in February of 2021 and immediately hit #1 on the New York Times, Wall Street Journal, USA Today, and Indie



bookstores' bestseller lists. Additionally, it was selected as a book club pick by the both Today Show and the Book of the Month club, which named it the best book of 2021. *The Nightingale* is currently in production at Tri Star, with Dakota and Elle Fanning set to star. Tri Star has also optioned *The Great Alone* and it is in development. *Firefly Lane*, her beloved novel about two best friends, was the #1 Netflix series around the world, in the week it came out. The popular tv show stars Katherine Heigl and Sarah Chalke and season two concluded the series on April 27, 2023.

The Sugar Creek Gourd Patch meets from 2-4:00 on the first and third Wednesdays of the month in the Thorntown Public Library meeting room. Visitors are welcome. Call Karen at the library to assure that supplies are on hand.

November through January, participants may work on their own projects, but gourds and supplies will be available for decoupage projects as well. The plan is to craft 7 additional 4" gourd squares for the gourd quilt. These may include fall leaves and snow flakes in order to increase the variety from flowers and butterflies. Job's Tears and needles will be on hand to allow participants to work on necklaces. Christmas ornaments are on the schedule for both November and December, and various sizes of gourds will be available. Snowflake patterns will be on hand for January 3 and 17 projects as we start a gourd 2024.
